

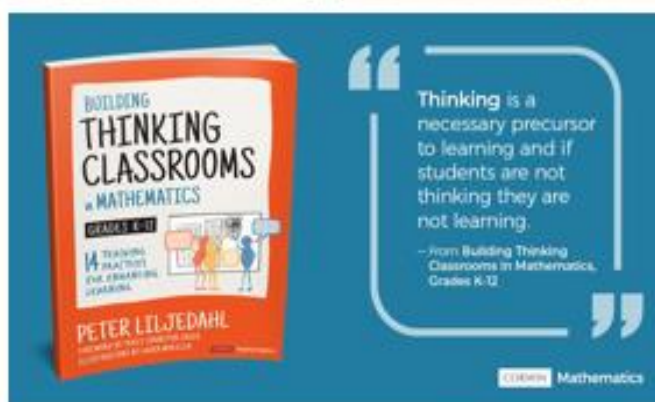




## MathUP, the 1<sup>st</sup> Five Minutes & the People Who Make it Happen!

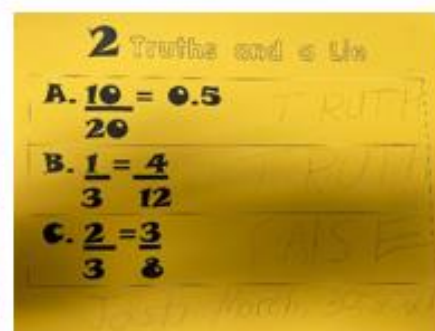
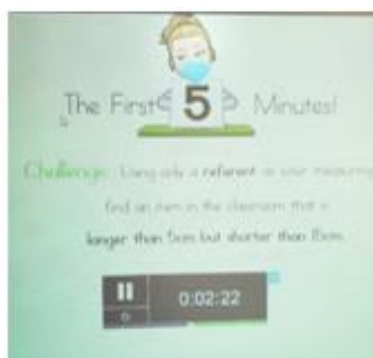
## The voices of students and teachers...

"I tried 2 Truths and a Lie within first five minutes of math today. Students were handed out a sheet with Three Fraction Comparisons where they had to determine which statements were true and which one was a lie. 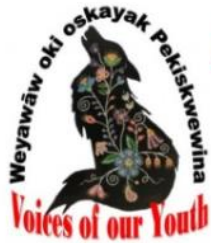
