November 9-SCC virtual meeting November 11/12- No classes November 16-Picture retake day <u>Report Cards</u> - Saskatchewan Rivers Public School Division will be implementing a new reporting schedule for the 2021-22 school year for elementary schools.

• Student Led Conferences - Parents, teachers and students will meet twice a year. Once in the fall (Tuesday, November 9) and again in early spring (Thursday, March 17) to discuss students strengths and to set learning goals for the student. This is a great opportunity for parents to learn about how their child has adapted to the new grade level and/or course. At this time, a teacher will share their observations about the child's progression in reading, writing, math and social skills or in their coursework. Any concerns will be raised with the intention of creating a supportive plan for the student.

In an effort to engage with our families and also respect everyone's need to feel safe, École Arthur Pechey Public School will be hosting a hybrid model of Student-Led/Parent-Teacher Conferences on **Tuesday, November 9**th from 3:15 to 8:15 p.m. Options include:

- coming into the school in person;
- connecting through a phone call.

Regardless of your preference, you should have received an email from your child's teacher with a link to use to sign up for a specific time. If you have not received an email or paper copy, please call the school to talk with your child's teacher and schedule a time for a conference.

• Report Cards- Report cards will be sent home twice a year. The first report card will be sent home Wednesday, February 2 and the second report card will go home at the end of the school year on Tuesday, June 28.

Our school provides supervision 8:35am-3:25pm. If your child requires supervision or child care outside of these hours, please make the appropriate arrangements.




Student Expectations
